Anthony "Tony" Cruz Munoz is the Chief, Diversity and Inclusion Officer, Pacific Air Forces, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii. The command is responsible for Air Force activities spread over half the globe in a command which supports a total force of 46,000 people serving principally in Hawaii, Alaska, Guam, Korea, and Japan.

He is the MAJCOM's principal advisor on all diversity and inclusion matters focused on creating cultures where every Airmen is free to reach their maximum potential and provides their greatest contribution to the mission. He provides guidance to senior leadership on areas of potential engagement to enhance mission effectiveness, speed, and lethality.

Mr. Cruz's background includes diverse duties within the personnel career field serving at the unit, base, Major Command, Joint Command, and Headquarters Air Force Personnel Center levels. He was also a First Sergeant and a Squadron Superintendent, before serving as a Wing Command Chief three times. He culminated his career as a Numbered Air Force Command Chief, where he provided leadership, guidance, and support to over 30 thousand Airmen across 9 installations in Europe and in Africa.

Mr. Cruz is a retired United States Air Force veteran with 29 years of service and entered federal civil service in February 2022.
