Colonel Harms is the Director of Safety, Headquarters Pacific Air Force, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam. Hawaii. He develops, executes, and evaluates Pacific Air Force aviation, ground, and weapons mishap prevention programs to preserve combat readiness. He oversees programs to promote safety awareness and mishap prevention, mishap investigations, evaluates corrective actions and ensures implementation for Commander PACAF. He also manages and employs Air Force safety and risk management to three numbered Air Forces.

Colonel Harms was commissioned through ROTC Det 880 at the Virgina Military Institute, Lexington, Va. He earned his first wings as Electronic Warfare Officer, but later earned his second wings as Pilot graduating Undergraduate Pilot Training from Naval Air Station Corpus Christi, TX spending the majority of his career in Air Force Special Operations assignments.

Colonel Harms has deployed extensively in support of combat operations in Afghanistan, Iraq, Horn of Africa and other small scale contingencies, and peace-keeping operations worldwide. He is a command pilot with more than 5,900 hours and over 2,500 combat hours in four different types of aircraft.
