LT COL MARK W. BERTHELOTTE

Lt Col Berthelotte is currently assigned to Headquarters Pacific Air Forces as the Director of the Commander's Action Group. He was born in Nashua, New Hampshire on December 6, 1981, where he attended Nashua High School and graduated in May 2000. After graduating high school Lt Col Berthelotte attended the University of New Hampshire where he earned his commission as a 2nd Lt in the Air Force through ROTC. He then arrived at Laughlin AFB, Texas on May 29, 2005 for Undergraduate Pilot Training and following this assignment he continued training at Corpus Christi Naval Air Station and Little Rock AFB. Lt Col Berthelotte then reported to his first operational unit flying C-130Hs at Dyess AFB in May 2007. He served 5 years at Dyess AFB where he was selected for the Phoenix Reach program retraining to the KC-135. In February 2012 Lt Col Berthelotte graduated training and arrived at RAF Mildenhall, England as his next duty station. During his tenure, Lt Col Berthelotte was assigned as a 351 Air Refueling Squadron Training Officer, 100th Operations Group Plans Exercise Strategy Officer, Chief of 100th Operations Group Training, Chief of Wing Readiness Inspections and Assistant Director of Operations for the 351st Air Refueling Squadron. In spring of 2016 Lt Col Berthelotte was assigned to the 603d Air



Operations Center where he commanded the Air Refueling Control Team. He was then selected for and completed Air Command and Staff College in 2018. His following assignment, to the 621st Contingency Response Wing, where he served as Operations Officer, Chief of Wing Safety and finally as unit commander to the 321st Contingency Response Squadron at Jt Base McGuire Dix Lakehurst, NJ. Finally, post command Lt Col Berthelotte reported to Joint Base Pearl Harbor Hickam where he served as North East Asia Branch Chief in Pacific Headquarters Plans, Programs and Strategy Division and currently sits as the Director of the Commander's Action Group Pacific Air Forces until the summer of 2024.
