

BRIGADIER GENERAL BRANDON D. PARKER

Brig. Gen. Brandon D. Parker is the Chief of Staff, Headquarters Pacific Air Forces, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii. He is responsible for the development of plans, policies, and procedures to ensure efficient operation of the Headquarters PACAF staff and the seamless interface with subordinate commands and agencies.

Brig. Gen. Parker is a 1996 graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy. Prior to becoming Chief of Staff, he deployed as Chief of Staff, Combined Joint Task Force-Operation Inherent Resolve, Union III Iraq. Brig. Gen. Parker commanded the 7th Bomb Wing, Dyess Air Force Base, Texas, and served as Vice Commander of the 2nd Bomb Wing, Barksdale AFB, Louisiana. He also commanded the 23rd Bomb Squadron, Minot AFB, North Dakota. His staff assignments included duty as an Executive Officer to the Chief of Staff of the U.S. Air Force, Director of Air Force Colonels Management, and as a Joint Planning Officer at Headquarters U.S. Strategic Command, Plans and Policy Directorate. Brig. Gen. Parker also deployed in support of operations Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom. He is a graduate of the U.S. Air Force Weapons School, the School of Advanced Air and Space Studies, Air Command and Staff College, and he served as a National Defense Fellow at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government. Brig. Gen. Parker is a command pilot with more than 2,800 hours in bomber aircraft and more than 380 combat hours.
