MAJOR GENERAL BRANDON D. PARKER

Major General Parker is the Director of Air and Cyberspace Operations, Pacific Air Forces, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii. His directorate is comprised of five divisions, two support squadrons, and the 613th Air and Space Operations Center. He is responsible to support the Pacific Air Forces Commander, the United States Pacific Command's Operations Center, and directing air operations in the Pacific Area of Responsibility, while leading 45,000 Airmen stationed in Japan, Korea, Alaska, and Guam.

Maj Gen Parker is a 1996 graduate of the Air Force Academy. His previous staff assignments included duty as Chief of Staff, Operation Inherent Resolve, Executive Officer to the Chief of Staff of the Air Force, Director of Air Force Colonels Management, and as a joint planning officer at Headquarters Strategic Command. He deployed in support of Operations Enduring Freedom, Iraqi Freedom, and Inherent Resolve. Maj Gen Parker commanded the 7th Bomb Wing, Dyess Air Force Base, Texas and the 23rd Bomb Squadron, Minot Air Force Base, North Dakota. He is a graduate of the Air Force Weapons School, the School of Advanced Air and Space Studies, and he served as a National Defense Fellow at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government. Prior to this, he served as the Chief of Staff, Headquarters Pacific Air Forces. Maj Gen Parker is a command pilot with more than 3,000 hours in bomber aircraft and more than 380 combat hours.
